NY State Licensing: For those individuals seeking a NY State Alarm License (6D). This course when taken in combination with the Level One Certified Alarm Technician, Advanced Intrusion and Fire Alarm Installation Methods and Courses, **in the state of NY** fulfill the 81 hour educational requirements.
